2017-2018 Key Targets

Based on actions taken during 2016 JCRB General and the US National Conferences the Education Committee is focused on the following key targets:

- Prepare and present education content at conferences which define and/or align with conference themes
- Provide SAMPLE courses and/or curricula that can be used by branches or members. Some of these samples will be chosen from the Quorum of Seventy library, some will be made available from branches, and some will be specifically prepared for JCRB. All material will be posted on the JCRB Education web site shortly after conference concludes.
 - To enable better efficiency in identifying and sharing SAMPLE courses and/or curricula the Education Committee has divided itself into six subcommittees: primary, elementary, intermediate, senior high, adult, and priesthood.
 - Each subcommittee will identify educational needs for its target audience by surveying branch and membership, identify the author or authors to prepare material for that need, and coordinate between branches to seek supporting material. Branches that have already create curricula or courses that have been used at least once may submit that material to the Committee for inclusion in the SAMPLE catalog.
 - All material made available by the JCRB Education Committee will utilize the JCRB Education Committee web site, thus allowing members and branches to download material at will.
