

**Minutes of the Mass Priesthood Meeting
And Mass Meeting of Melchisedec Priesthood**
Wednesday, April 17, 2019

A mass meeting of priesthood attending the Joint Conference of Restoration Branches conference was called to order by JCRB vice president David Whiting and patriarch Fred Greene offered an opening prayer.

The meeting was held to address the issue of naming an acting bishop after Bishop Carl Cederstrom had indicated that he was unable to continue to serve as a bishop for the conference.

The matter of naming Rob Rolfe as acting bishop beyond the interim period in which Brother Cederstrom had asked Brother Rolfe to function had been discussed in the various quorum groups previously. The Quorum of High Priests (including Apostles and Patriarchs), Seventy and Elders and the Aaronic mass meeting each had indicated support for the matter at these meetings.

Brother Whiting read the resolution that will come before the conference on Thursday April 18, and the vote to support the resolution by the mass meeting of priesthood was unanimous.


Following the vote, the Aaronic priesthood left the meeting and the mass meeting of Melchisedec priesthood was opened, again under the leadership of Brother Whiting. Brother Whiting read from the criteria for president from the JCRB resolutions.

Nominations for president of the conference were opened with the names of Fred Greene and Sherman Phipps being offered. When a vote was held, the name of Fred Greene was selected as the nominee of the mass meeting and is being shared with the conference in these minutes.

A standing vote of appreciation for the leadership of Brother Sherman Phipps this then given.
